Timeless Classic

The power of black and white makes a splash in this retro-inspired master bath in Lavallette. Designed like a piece of fine furniture, the focal-point vanity features shapely oval mirrors flanked with recessed panel pilasters and double wall sconces for added elegance, cabinetry designer Peter Salerno says. A small window and ledge - incorporated into the medicine cabinet - embraces natural light while offering convenient shelf storage. The six-foot tub is placed on a raised panel platform in the far right corner beneath a triple shuttered window. Classic basket-weave marble floor tiles were installed on a diagonal to complement the tub's 45-degree clipped corners. Recessing the shower into the wall visually reduces its size, says Salerno, a certified master kitchen and bath designer. Visible from the seamless doors is an artful mosaic border and picture-frame design interspersed with black mosaic dots. Interior designer Robert Wilson, who planned the design scheme, chose a textured black grass cloth for the walls as a strong backdrop to the white surfaces. A chic crystal chandelier provides the finishing touch.
